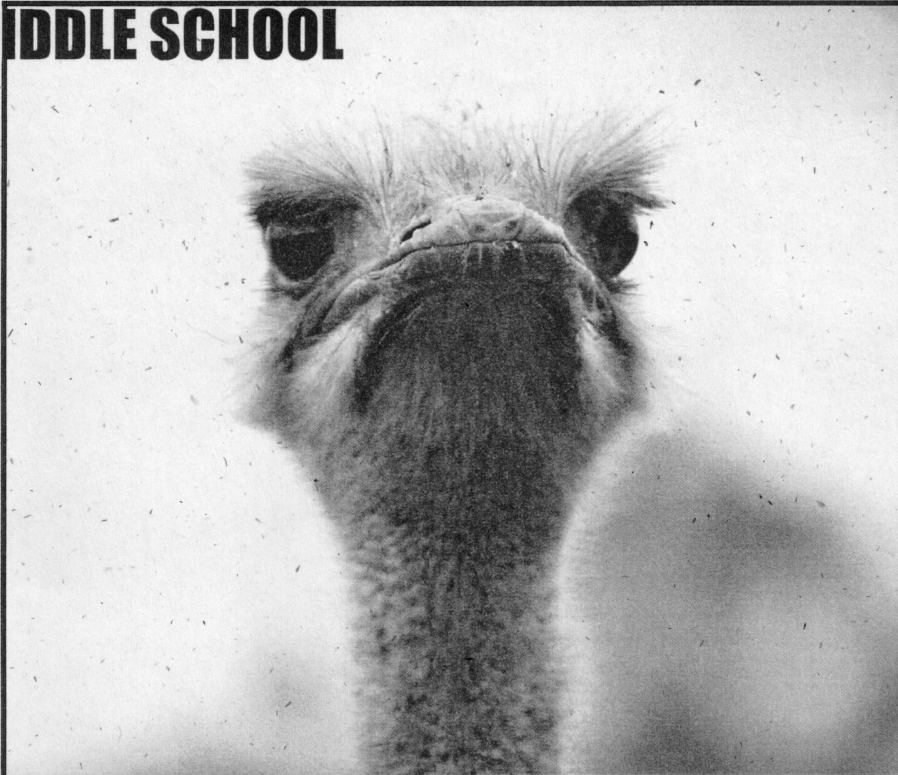


FEATURED ART FROM KULSHAN MIDDLE SCHOOL

The curricular unit was designed in conjunction with Western Gallery's winter exhibit-- "For the Birds." This traveling show featured both metaphorical and literal representations of bird-related imagery and sculptures. Our unit features bird images on ceramic tiles that are decorated with 3-dimensional wing constructions. Artist statements were also completed regarding each student's concepts of their work and will be presented in the exhibit catalogue that accompanies the exhibit. A field trip to the university culminated the project wherein students will engage in an arts-based scavenger hunt and gallery-related challenges.
